STREET MOVES: Morgan Stanley Hires Father/Son From Raymond James

NEW YORK (Dow Jones)--Morgan Stanley (MS) recruited Edward and Joey Warwick from Raymond James Financial Inc. (RJF) on Friday to work in Chattanooga, Tenn.

The father/son team had prior fees and commissions of \$1.02 million and prior assets under management of \$100 million. They will report to Todd Phillips, the branch manager.

Edward Warwick worked at Raymond James since 1994 and Joey Warwick worked there since 2006. He's also worked as a lawyer and at MetLife Securities.
